Progress to Date and Next Steps

CMM Adaptation:

- Engagement at different levels MOH at a national subnational level to adapt the CMM
- In the current situation (reprioritisation of VTP services) we will use the CMM as tool in the
 planning process and the national reprioritization (adapted Tier 1 Tool) outputs to create a
 pathway for planning and implementation of the Prioritised VTP Package at subnational level

Scoping of Linking and Learning Platforms in countries:

- Detailed scoping to better understand the existing linking and learning platforms (meetings, coordination, training materials and methodologies, resources hubs and virtual platforms including applications)
- This helps to understand where VTP sits and how to strengthen what exists in country and what is most utilised. Going forward to focus on where to build capacity, and cascade learnings and resources rapidly and efficiently



Progress to Date and Next Steps

Subnational Technical Support

- Engagement with MOH has helped to identify HIVE priority provinces, districts and facilities.
 A facility baselines assessment was undertaken in each of the facilities (60).
- The results of the facility baseline assessments will be used to guide the discussions on reprioritisation of VTP services (in the implementation of a Prioritised VTP Package) at subnational level in tandem with the CMM and Tier tool data from national level
- The results will guide the QI approach and inform trouble shooting of the implementation of the Prioritised VTP Package. The lessons and best practices will be fed up to national and shared across linking and learning platforms.
- One of the key themes was capacity building on implementation of VTP guidelines at facility level, which is a key priority area in light of staff movements and integration
- Key **outputs** for this year would be (training material, job aids, SOPS, documentation of best practices a etc.) on the Prioritised VTP Package with linking to national resource hubs

Progress to Date and Next Steps

Placement of HIVE within the Global Alliance and VTP TWGs at regional national and provincial level:

- Country leads have aligned the HIVE activities with the Global Alliance Plans and have established pillar 2 sub working groups at national and provincial level to ensure VTP as an area of focus
- Additionally, PATA being a key stakeholder in the Global Alliance Regionally
- This assist in the review of the GA plans in alignment with national guidance and the Prioritized VTP Service Package



Summarising Our Approach, Outputs, and Impacts







Approach

- Alignment of national reprioritization (adapted Tier 1 Tool) at subnational to inform action planning
- Hosting of national and subnational meetings to create prioritized VTP plans
- Strengthen /create the linking and learning platforms as prioritized by 2
- Support Implementation of a Prioritized Package of VTP Interventions through direct TA in priority sites and cascading through the linking and learning platforms
- Creation of resources such as case studies, SOPs, training videos etc. (keeping sustainability in mind) from the bottom



Outputs by June 2026

- A VTP Prioritized Package from the bottom up and evidence based, informed from lesson through implementation
- Capacity building on implementation of the Prioritized Package of VTP services
- A prioritized set of M&E indicators at subnational level aligned with national guidance
- A set of risk and mitigation strategies from implementation
- Sustainable linking and learning platforms that are scalable



Impacts

- Maintenance of past gains through the implementation of Prioritised
 VTP Package with a focus on selected areas of the cascade:
 - Decreased mother to child transmission of HIV
 - Reduced HIV related morbidity and mortality of PBFW with HIV
 - Improved health/decreased morbidity and mortality among infants with HIV infection



Way Forward at a Subnational Level

- Assistance with the national meetings to fast track the creation of the report back slides and spreadsheet
- Hosting of similar meetings at a subnational level to replicate national priority setting
 processes to ensure that there is alignment with the revised VPT service adaptations and
 guidance from national level reprioritization (adapted Tier 1 Tool)
- Technical assistance to the Global Alliance sub working groups and Technical Working Groups at national and subnational level to assist in the prioritisation of activities in alignment with the guidance from national. Revisiting of national Global Alliance priority plans created over the 3rd and 4th of June 2025
- Support implementation of a Prioritized Package of VTP Interventions through direct TA in priority sites and cascading through the linking and learning platforms
- Through strengthening of Linking and Learning Platforms, creation of resources such as case studies, SOPs, training videos etc. (keeping sustainability in mind) from the bottom up
