Adapting to funding crisis

Impact of Donor Funding Cuts

- Stop work order disrupted HIV services
- Anticipated more funding cuts post-September 2025 pose serious risks

Tanzania's Experience

- EID integrated into routine RCH services
- Challenges with sample transport and DBS kit stock-outs addressed through redistribution

Critical Questions for EID Access

- Will testing supplies and reagents be sufficient?
- Will children receive timely results and treatment?
- Who will reach families with limited access?

Accelerating Sustainability

- We need **political will** and **system resilience**
- Community engagement is **essential**
- Governments to expand health budgets and ring-fence HIV funding
- Engage private sector and form effective public-private partnerships
